

Player and Parent Commitment and Code of Ethics 2009-2010



I/WE have received a full copy of and I/WE have read the Chesterfield United Football Clubs' Player and Parent Commitment and Code of Ethics for the 2009-2010 season. I/WE understand and I/WE agree to abide by the rules of conduct and club guidelines as stated therein in full.

Spectator Area - All spectators are to take the side of the field opposite the teams. Spectators should remain at least 3 feet behind the touchline. If, during the match, the spectators' behavior is out of line then the referee will ask the coaches to speak to the spectators. If the behavior continues, it is within the discretion of the referee to ask the offending spectator(s) to leave the venue. The referee shall abandon the match if the spectators become unruly and out of control.

Team Area - Both teams are required to take the same side of the field. The "home" team is responsible for choosing the side of the field the teams will occupy. Members of each team will remain on opposite sides of the centerline. Team officials and players are to remain between the centerline and the 18-yard line. All are to be at least 3 feet behind the touchline.

NOTE: Any player, coach or spectator who encourages a team or individual member of a team to intentionally injure or physically abuse a member of another team is guilty of a serious breach of the CUFC Code of Conduct and may be sanctioned. Chesterfield United reserves the right to dismiss any player or parent from the club that is a disruptive influence or behaves in such a way that is negative towards the club, team or coach.

VYSA Referee Assault/Abuse Policy: Any spectator who verbally abuses or assaults a referee shall be sanctioned by VYSA and Chesterfield United Football Club (CUFC).

By signing, I/WE understand that my/our privileges to attend games as a spectator can be suspended for violation of this Code of Conduct.
